N Chautauqua Blvd Corridor Improvements

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

N Chautauqua Blvd a major North/South corridor in the North Portland peninsula connecting N Columbia Blvd to N Willamette Blvd. This busy street serves as the western border of the Kenton and Arbor Lodge neighborhoods and the eastern border of the Portsmouth and University Park neighborhoods.

This project would add traffic calming and speed reader boards to reduce speeds on the corridor, especially on the northern end where the street is wider and development is set back further from the street. It would also improve existing crossings and add new safer pedestrian crossings to help people get across the street. This project would explore adding new protected bike lanes beginning at the N Columbia Blvd trail and heading south to logical ending point on the bike network. Additional project elements could include increasing tree canopy, street lighting, and other streetscape improvements.
