N Lombard St Critical Connection


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

N Lombard St is the primary connection for people moving between St Johns and the rest of the peninsula neighborhoods in North Portland. This bridge is owned and maintained by the BNSF railroad, but the roadway is managed by the Oregon Department of Transportation. It is a primary response route for the Portland Fire Bureau, carries frequent transit service, and is an important walking and bike route.

This near-term project would improve crossings of N Lombard at the Peninsula Crossing Trail and close the bike lane gap on N Lombard St between N Macrum Ave and N Ida Ave. Final design and implementation of this project requires approval by the Oregon Department of Transportation as they maintian the roadway on N Lombard St over the BNSF-owned bridge over the railroad cut.
